2. Examinations

- The Psychiatry in-house practical exam is the Clinical Reasoning Exam and we are looking for faculty to help mark these paper exams (30 students every six weeks, double-marked)
- In Year 4, students perform a multi-station, clinical exam that employs standardized patients (OSCE). This is held on several weekends: February through June—either or both Saturday and Sunday, either or both morning and afternoon sessions. Generally examiners are matched with their disciplines.
